



APEIRON LPS 1175: ISSUE 7 SECURITY RATING 2, 3 AND 4 UPGRADABLE DOOR SET

Revolutionising speed of response to escalating threat levels.

Hodgson Sayers has developed a security door set that is not only available in LPS 1175: Issue 7 Security Rating 2, 3 & 4 but, for the first time ever, can be upgraded from any of the lower levels to any of the higher levels without having to throw your initial investment away!

The patent-protected Apeiron door set is upgradable years after the equipment has even been installed. Upgradable from LPS 1175: Issue 7 Security Rating 2 through to LPS 1175: Issue 7 Security Rating 4, the doors could go to a higher rating if required.

The doors and frames are adjusted to accommodate the opening sizes and the typical frame weight can be easily fitted by a two-man crew and is significantly lighter than many other products on the market.

The outer leaf of the lead door is formed to create an interleave with the corresponding interleave of the fixed door. As such, this creates a door joint offering enhanced environmental sealing performance as well as an impenetrable barrier even up to LPS 1175: Issue 7 Security Rating 4 attacks.

The outer leaf is made from 3mm thick mild steel. LPS 1175: Issue 7 Security Rating 2, 3 and 4 door sets have two hinges at the top. Level 3 and 4 have two hinges at the bottom, while level 2 has a single hinge. This concealment means that it is not possible to attack the hinges without first attacking the outer door leaf. As such, the concealment means that there are no visible areas of weakness as to where to start the attack.

The hinge action positions the front of the outer door leaf behind the frame section over the entire leaf of the door.
